



5 YEARS OLD

READ!

- Five-year-olds enjoy longer stories with more words than pictures.
- Read everything you see, not just books — street signs, cereal boxes, and magazines.

TALK!

- Point out the link between letters and sounds using your child's name. Joey and jump begin with the same sound. They both begin with the same letter, J.
- Ask your child how the story is like other things he sees or does. Does he ever feel the same way the person in the story feels?

PLAY!

- Help your child do a simple play or puppet show.
- Tell stories to your child, and ask him to tell you stories.
